

世界各國如何在新冠病毒疫情下推動狂犬病防疫？

德國在 GARC 網站提出之應變策略

We are planning to give several interviews for Radio stations, newspapers and - depending on the pandemic Situation - also inform people in the center of Munich about Rabies, World Rabies Day, GARC and our work with animals. Our main Goal is to educate people about the danger with rabies in bats (which is an unknown danger for most people in Germany) as well as educate them about the risks when interacting with unknown strays or even trafficking strays during their Holidays. Also, an important Goal for us is to make people understand, not to buy illegal bred puppies from Southeastern Europe since they also can bring rabies into western Europe countries. Also, it is our Goal to remember people about the horrifying consequences for people in third world countries when they get bitten by rabid animals and don't get proper Treatment.

我們計劃讓廣播電台、報紙等媒體進行多次採訪，並根據疫情向慕尼黑的市民介紹狂犬病、世界狂犬病日、GARC 以及我們在動物方面的工作。主要目標是宣導蝙蝠狂犬病的危險（德國大多數人不知道其危險性），並教育他們在假期與未知的流浪動物互動，以及在**販賣流浪動物**時的風險。我們的另一個重要宣導目標是，不要從（南）東歐購買非法繁殖的幼犬，因為它們也會將狂犬病帶入西歐國家。此外，我們的目標是讓人們記住第三世界國家的人們在被狂犬病動物咬傷而沒有得到適當治療時所面臨的可怕後果。
